Tallahassee Museum Successfully Completes Grant

Tallahassee, FL – The Tallahassee Museum is pleased to announce the successful completion of its General Operating Support Grant.

The Historical Museums Grants-in-Aid Program awarded \$53,069 to the Museum in October 2005. This grant recognized the Tallahassee Museum's efforts to preserve and interpret Florida's rich heritage in the Big Bend region. Within this competitive grant program, the Museum was ranked 2nd out of a field of 28 history museums across the state with budgets over \$300,000.

This project has been financed in part with Historical Museum Grants-in-Aid Program assistance provided by the Bureau of Historical Museums, Division of Historical Resources, Florida Department of State, Secretary of State.
